In supersession of this Department's Notification No. AHY-A(9)-1/2012, dated 01.06.2017 & 18.07.2019, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to renotify the H.P. State Government Policy/Guidelines for the purchase of Veterinary Medicines as under:-

<u>Title: Himachal Pradesh State Government Policy Guidelines for the Purchase of Veterinary Medicines</u>

GUII	DING PRINCIPLES:
1.	Quality, Price, Reliability and Supply Stability to be the main criteria for carrying out transactions.
II.	Fair Competition to be ensured by the Department of animal Husbandry, HP and the tendering/facilitating agency (HP Woolfed).
III.	Medicines etc. to be purchased/procured in a transparent manner. To ensure transparency, tender documents should provide all the necessary information to facilitate submission of appropriate and competitive tenders.
IV.	All the bidders to be treated with fairness and it is ensured that they are given the same level of information for preparing quotations/tenders.
V.	Quotations and tenders to be evaluated on competitiveness in pricing after laying down quality standards.
VI.	Purchase of medicines etc. to be in accordance with the prevailing disease pattern and local requirements.
VII.	Creation of buffer stock of medicines for emergencies like disease out break, natural calamities etc.
VIII.	Long term sustainability of the sector by providing excellent and qualitative animal health care.

D.	Purchase/Procurement Procedure		
1.	The purchases of Veterinary medicines would be resorted to by way of inviting open tenders under two bid (Technical and Financial) system through newspaper, Web portal etc. by the Nodal Agency for the procurement of these medicines.		
2.	On the basis of the requirements in the field, the list of medicines to be procured/purchased (For which RC/s is/are to be finalized and issued) will be decided by a Committee of officers of the Department to be constituted by the Director AH, as and when required, for onward transmission to the Nodal Agency.		
3.	The Tender Document will be prepared and finalized by the Nodal Agency in consultation and with the approval of the Director AH with adequate safe-guards in respect of quality, timely supply of the medicines etc. and penalties for infringements of the tender terms by the approved tenderer(s).		
4.	Policy for purchase of Veterinary Medicine would be approved on the easy availability of Allopathic medicines of the same brand/company in the market.		
5(a).	The technical bids would be opened by a Technical Sub Committee to be		
	headed by the Managing Director, HP Wool Federation Ltd. With Deputy Director (Epidemiology), Sr Veterinary Officer/Veterinary Officer (Epidemiology) and one representative of Director Animal Husbandry as members. E.	Payments		
1	The due payments shall be released by the indenters directly to the RC parties through NEFT/RTGS or other bank instruments.		
2	Starting 2019-20, the HP Wool Federation will collect 5% (five) handling charges directly from the concerned supplier (firm/ RC Party) on the basis of supply order issued by it, in respect of Medicines and other material etc. For this purpose, the HP Wool Federation will raise the bills to the concerned supplier(s) (firm/ RC Party) on fortnightly/monthly basis. The suppliers (firm/ RC Party) will be required to remit the amount of handling charges within ten days from the date of bill(s) failing which no fresh		
*	order will be placed/issued and the act of non-remittance of handling charges by the supplier (firm/ RC Party) will be considered as infringement of the terms and conditions governing the supply agreement/rate contract. The intenders/ Director AH will, accordingly from 2019-20 onwards, remit		
	full due payments (100% payment) to the supplier (firm/ RC Party) on account of successful supplies.		
3	The deduction/charging of taxes will be the responsibility of the supplier and the indenters and all laws, guidelines and orders in this regard will be fully complied with timely by all concerned.		
F.	Validity		
1.	The rate contract of Veterinary Medicines to be finalized based on tender and		
	approval of SLPC shall be kept valid for a maximum duration of two years from the date of issue of rate contract, unless otherwise approved by the SLPC and specified/clarified in the Rate Contract letter.		
2.	The power to extend the validity of Rate Contract(s) will rest with the Director AH maximum for a period of six months from the date of expiry. However, in such circumstances specific reasons will be recorded in writing.		
G.	Quality Assurance		
1.	Whenever felt necessary the indenters will be at a liberty to assess quality of medicines by way of clinical trials by the Department of Veterinary Medicines, Veterinary College Palampur and/or by way of getting samples tested from NABL accredited Drug Testing Laboratory or any other Lab or both at the cast of manufacturer/supplier.		
2.	The indenters, as per the present practice, will be responsible to accept only the quality medicines and for getting the medicines tested regularly for ensuring the quality of the medicines in accordance with the terms of the rate contract/laid down procedure(s) and in case of any shortcoming(s) the matter will be reported to the Director AH in a time bound manner for decision.		
3.	Where medicines supplied are found not acceptable due to damage in transit, wrong supply and are consequently rejected, the indenter concerned shall immediately notify such rejection specifying the grounds on which such rejection has been made, to the supplier, Director AH and the Nodal Agency and take necessary action for getting the items replaced as per the specification of the Supply Order. The Nodal Agency shall follow up the matter with the suppliers.

Dispute Redressal Committee (DRC) under the Chairmanship of Joint Director 4. to be nominated by the Director, Animal Husbandry with following members will decide all types of issues related to purchase and supply of Veterinary Medicines /equipment etc. during the period of validity of rate contract:-(a) Managing Director, H.P. Wool Federation / his representative. (b) Assistant Controller (F&A), Directorate of Animal Husbandry (c) Two Technical Officers, Directorate of Animal Husbandry to be nominated by the Director Animal Husbandry. (d) Representative of Drug Controller, H.P. The above Dispute Redressal Committee shall meet as and when required and make recommendations to Director, Animal Husbandry, H.P. whose decision will be final. **GENERAL** The powers to purchase the Veterinary Medicines are already delegated by the 1 Government to the Director, Animal Husbandry. These powers stand further delegated to the Controlling Officers. 2 The Director, Animal Husbandry HP will henceforth have special powers to purchase Veterinary Medicines required in emergency up to Rs. 3,00,000/- in each financial year from the open market subject to fulfilling all codal formalities and the availability of budget. The Controlling Officers/field in charges will have the power to purchase veterinary medicines up to Rs. 1,00,000/- in each financial year from the open market under extreme emergency after fulfilling all codal formalities and subject to the approval of the Director Animal Husbandry, HP. Similarly, Incharge of all Livestock Farms will have the power to purchase veterinary medicines up to Rs. 50,000/- in each financial year from the open market under extreme emergency after fulfilling all codal formalities and subject to the approval of the Director, Animal Husbandry, HP. The interpretation of the Addl. Chief Secretary/Pr. Secretary/Secretary (AH) to 3 the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh in respect of this policy will be treated as final. The Nodal Agency can facilitate the procurement of medicines etc. ibid as per 4 this policy to other Departments etc. also in case desired/requested by them. **APPEALS** Wherever difficulties arise in interpreting these rules, the decision of the Addl. Chief Secretary/Pr. Secretary/Secretary (AH) to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh will be treated as final. The Addl. Chief Secretary/Pr. Secretary/Secretary (AH) to the Govt. of Himachal 2 Pradesh or such person nominated by the Addl. Chief Secretary/Pr. Secretary/Secretary (AH) to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh will be the arbitrator in case of dispute(s) arising between the concerned parties (i.e. Director AH/Nodal Agency and the Tenderers/RC Parties) in the matter. Henceforth, the Administrative Secretary (A.H.) to the Govt. of HP shall have the power to review and give final decision on the penalties imposed by the Director AH on the rate contract parties after recording the reason(s), in the event the concerned party(ies) make a representation in this regard. Only the courts in Shimla will have the jurisdiction to take up the matters 3 pertaining to the dispute(s) arising between the parties concerned (i.e. Director AH/Nodal Agency and the Tenderers/RC Parties).

WRITE OFF AND DISPOSAL

The Director AH shall annually constitute a stores survey and disposal committee of not less than three members at least two of whom will be Class-I officers. This committee shall survey the non-consumable medicines/ equipments (if any) and recommend write-off for items, which are not usable/ unserviceable/expired. The committee shall record the reasons for recommending write-off. The Director AH shall take action in the matter as per rules.
